Format

While you are free to use this printable however you'd like, here's what we had in mind when designing it: Each weekly verse begins on a Monday; therefore, week I begins on January 4. JANUARY

- week 7: Don't be afraid, for I am with you. Don't be discouraged, for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you. I will hold you up with my victorious right hand. *Isaiah 41:10 (NLT)*
- week 8: Wise words are more valuable than much gold and many rubies. *Proverbs 20:15* (NLT)
- week 9: The Spirit gives life; the flesh counts for nothing. The words I have spoken to you they are full of the Spirit and life. *John 6:63 (NIV)*

MARCH

- Week 10: May the words of my mouth and the meditation of my heart be pleasing to you, O Lord, my Rock and my Redeemer. Psalm 19:14 (NLT)
- week 11: Let your conversation be always full of grace, seasoned with salt, so that you may know how to answer everyone. *Colossians 4:6 (NIV)*
- week 12: ...Behold, I have set before you an open door, which no one will be able to shut... *Revelation 3:8 (ESV)*
- week 13: For God gave us a spirit not of fear but of power and love and self-control. 2 Timothy 1:7 (ESV)

APRIL

- week 14: Avoid godless chatter, because those who indulge in it will become more and more ungodly. *Timothy 2:16 (NIV)*
- week 15: Casting the whole of your care [all your anxieties, all your worries, all your concerns, once and for all] on Him, for He cares for you affectionately and cares about you watchfully. *I Peter 5:7 (AMP)*
- week 16: ...And all the people among whom you are shall see the work of the Lord, for it is an awesome thing that I will do with you. *Exodus 34:10 (ESV)*
- week 17: And he said to him, "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind." *Matthew 22:37 (ESV)*

MAY

- week 18: Be completely humble and gentle; be patient, bearing with one another in love. *Ephesians 4:2 (NIV)*
- week 19: But you, Lord, are a shield around me, my glory, the One who lifts my head high. *Psalm 3:3 (NIV)*
- week 20: For he who is mighty has done great things for me, and holy is his name. Luke 1:49 (ESV)
- week 21: Watch over your heart with all diligence; for from it flow the springs of life. Proverbs 4:23 (NASB)
- week 22: I sought the Lord, and he answered me and delivered me from all my fears.

 Psalm 34:4 (ESV)

JUNE

- week 23: "I have said these things to you, that in me you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation. But take heart; I have overcome the world." *John 16:33 (ESV)*
- week 24: My son, pay attention to my wisdom, turn your ear to my words of insight, that you may maintain discretion and your lips may preserve knowledge. *Proverbs 5:I-2 (NIV)*
- week 25: He is before all things, and in him all things hold together. Colossians 1:17 (NIV)
- week 26: O Sovereign Lord! You made the heavens and earth by your strong hand and powerful arm. Nothing is too hard for you! *Jeremiah 32:17 (NLT)*

JULY....

- week 27: For God is greater than our worried hearts and knows more about us than we do ourselves. I John 3:20 (MSG)
- week 28: Let us hold unswervingly to the hope we profess, for He who promised is faithful. Hebrews 10:23 (NIV)
- week 29: I wait for the Lord, my soul waits, and in his word I hope... Psalm 130:5 (ESV)
- week 30: My heart is confident in You, O God: my heart is confident. No wonder I can sing Your praises! *Psalm 57:7 (NLT)*

AUGUST

- week 31: The Lord will fight for you, and you have only to be still. *Exodus* 14:14 (NIV)
- week 32: When you walk, your step will not be hampered, and if you run, you will not stumble. *Proverbs 4:12 (ESV)*
- week 33: Let your roots grow down into him, and let your lives be built on him. Then your faith will grow strong in the truth you were taught, and you will overflow with thankfulness. *Colossians 2:7 (NLT)*
- week 34: You, Lord, are my lamp; the Lord turns my darkness into light. 2 Samuel 22:29 (NIV)
- week 35: Though he brings grief, he also shows compassion because of the greatness of his unfailing love. *Lamentations 3:32 (NLT)*

SEPTEMBER

- week 36: Though an army encamp against me, my heart shall not fear; though war arise against me, yet I will be confident. *Psalm 27:3 (ESV)*
- Week 37: Have I not commanded you? Be strong and of good courage; do not be afraid, nor be dismayed, for the Lord your God is with you wherever you go. *Joshua I:9* (NIV)
- week 38: If any of you lacks wisdom, you should ask God, who gives generously to all without finding fault, and it will be given to you. *James 1:4-5 (NIV)*
- week 39: But if we are living in the light, as God is in the light, then we have fellowship with each other, and the blood of Jesus, his Son, cleanses us from all sin.

OCTOBER

- week 40: Restore to me the joy of your salvation, and uphold me with a willing spirit. Psalm 51:12 (ESV)
- week 41: My heart says of You "seek His face!". Your face, Lord, I will seek. Psalm 27:8 (NIV)
- week 42: You will seek Me and find Me when you search for Me with all of your heart. *Jeremiah 29:13 (NASB)*
- week 43: He who dwells in the shelter of the Most High will abide in the shadow of the Almighty. *Psalm 91:1 (ESV)*
- week 44: You gave a wide place for my steps under me, and my feet did not slip. Psalm 18:36 (ESV)

NOVEMBER

- week 45: Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil, for you are with me; your rod and your staff, they comfort me. *Psalm 23:4 (ESV)*
- week 46: Consider it pure joy, my brothers and sisters, whenever you face trials of many kinds, because you know that the testing of your faith produces perseverance. Let perseverance finish its work so that you may be mature and complete, not lacking anything. *James 1:2-4 (NIV)*
- week 47: Whatever your hand finds to do, do it with your might... Ecclesiastes 9:10 (ESV)
- Week 48: Blessed (happy, fortunate, to be envied) are they who keep His testimonies, and who seek, inquire for and of Him and crave Him with the whole heart. *Psalm 119:2* (AMP)

DECEMBER

- But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you. And you will be my witnesses, telling people about me everywhere--in Jerusalem, throughout Judea, in Samaria, and to the ends of the earth. *Acts I:8 (NLT)*
- week 50: Commit your way to the Lord; trust in him, and he will act. Psalm 37:5 (ESV)
- Week 51: But God is so rich in mercy, and he loved us so much, that even though we were dead because of our sins, he gave us life when he raised Christ from the dead. (It is only by God's grace that you have been saved!) Ephesians 2:4-5 (NLT)
- Week 52: Peace I leave with you; my peace I give you. I do not give to you as the world gives. Do not let your hearts be troubled and do not be afraid. *John 14:27 (NIV)*
